11. LGBT History Month (February)
 1. NNP will be expected to make a short presentation on the two projects funded by the LGBT History month Group (Pride Scarf Project & Sylvia Townsend Warner Project).
 2. Pieter has initiated a project on behalf of NNP – the creation of a quilt panel for the Norwich Pride Quilt. The panel will take the form of a cross stitch panel and will feature the NNP Beach Chill-Out 2011 (as the main historic event for 2011). The intention is that the project will be a communal one open to anyone wanting to participate – they can borrow the panel for a week at a time and complete as much of the design as they feel capable of doing. The quilt and the work associated with the quilt will feature in the LGBT History Month Programme and NNP may decide to participate in this activity.
 3. Freedom of Expression – a public debate.
It is proposed that NNP promote a public debate for sometime in February as part of the LGBT History Month campaign. Hilary Koe is eminently suitable with a keen interest in

the subject, a legal background and a background in lecturing. Costs, date & venue and advertising need to be considered.
